PATHWAYS TO PROGRESS CONGLOM – RISE OF A NEW DAY AND RAISE IN STUDENTS' MIND

In our school, a new, still powerful practice known as **'CONGLOM'** or the **MORNING MEETING** has been implemented this year. Each day begins with a conglomeration after their significant start of the day in roller assembly. This conglom is timetabled right at the start of the school day; this short session offers students a calm and connected beginning. Our school has scheduled conglom from Grade Balavatika 1 to Grade 12

Conglom is a space where students and teachers gather to:

- Share thoughts and opinions,
- Discuss the day's or Week's plans,
- Reflect on values, current events, or personal goals,
- Celebrate achievements, big or small.

This circle became a **valuable opportunity for bonding**, helping students feel seen, heard, and supported. It also strengthened the teacher-student relationship and encouraged a sense of belonging within the classroom community.

What began as a simple meeting evolved into a **safe**, **positive space** that nurtures emotional well-being, empathy, and self-awareness — all before the first bell rings.



















MAKING LEARNING VISIBLE: A NEW APPROACH TO PTMS

This year, our school proudly introduced a fresh and meaningful approach to the traditional Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) — one that places the spotlight on **student voice**, **reflection**, **and visible learning**.

In this newly launched format, PTMs are no longer just a platform for teachers to report academic progress. Instead, they are designed as **collaborative conversations** between students, teachers, and parents, focusing on **how much the student has understood**, and more importantly, **how they reflect on their learning journey.**

Students are encouraged to present a **brief gist or summary of the lessons** they've learned, and sharing:

- What key concepts they have grasped
- Where they struggled to get the concept understood
- How they overcame challenges, and
- What strategies helped them learn best.

This reflective practice not only builds confidence but also develops metacognition — the ability to think about one's own thinking. Teachers guide students in preparing these learning summaries, ensuring that the core objectives of each lesson are internalized, not just memorized.

Our school conducted the **MAKING LEARNING VISIBLE** for all the grades from Balavatika to 12th, in which the students' participation and performance can be very much appreciated, and it has turned out to be a proud moment for the parents observing their wards' voracious preparation and execution of their talents.

This initiative aligns with a broader goal of making learning visible — a concept that values transparency, reflection, and student empowerment.

We believe that when students actively participate in conversations about their own learning, true

education begins to unfold — not just in classrooms, but in life.

Key Preparation Points for "Making Learning Visible" PTM

★ Invitation to the Principal and Stakeholders:

Marks the formal beginning of the planning process.

★ Selection and Training of Comperes:

Students are chosen to host and guide the session confidently.

★ Subject-wise Student Preparation:

Students prepare short summaries of lessons, reflecting on understanding and learning methods.

★ Focus on Student Reflection:

Emphasis on what was learned, challenges faced, and how they were overcome.

★ Use of Learning Aids:

Visuals, models, charts, and creative tools are used to support explanations.

★ Teacher Facilitation and Guidance:

Teachers mentor students, provide feedback, and help structure content.

★ Rehearsals and Peer Review:

Practice sessions are held to build confidence and clarity in communication.

★ Parent-Principal-Pedagogue Meeting:

Meeting fosters collaboration between families, school leadership, and teachers to support students' academic and personal development.






STUDENT-LED CONFERENCE ON "REAL-TIME MATHEMATICS" BY GRADES 11 & 12

NUCLEAR AWARENESS PROGRAMME

As part of the Nuclear Awareness Programme, students of Class XI visited the IGCAR Nodal Center, Pallavaram, in two batches on 26th August 2025 and 28th August 2025. A total of 75 students participated — 37 students from Classes XI A, C, and D, and 38 students from Class XI B,accompanied by Ms. K. Srividhya (Academic Coordinator) and Ms. S. Anitha (PGT Chemistry).

The programme began with a visual presentation of IGCAR, Kalpakkam, showcasing various reactors and their working principles. This was followed by an enlightening session by Ms. Jalaja Madana Mohan, who explained the importance of nuclear awareness.

Students then explored the exhibition hall that displayed detailed miniature models, such as the Pressurized Heavy Water Reactor (PHWR – 700 MW), Fast Breeder Test Reactor (FBTR) fuel assemblies, Prototype Fast Breeder Reactor (PFBR), Light Water Reactor, Radiopharmaceutical applications, Bhabhatron, Gamma Chamber 5000, and Decay Heat Removal System (SGDHRS). The faculty explained each model clearly, helping students gain a deeper understanding of nuclear energy, electricity generation, and the medical applications of radiation, especially in imaging and cancer treatment.

The exhibition also highlighted the life and contributions of eminent scientists, particularly Dr. Homi J. Bhabha, the father of India's nuclear programme. Students actively took part in quizzes and puzzles based on the exhibits. Winners were awarded caps and periodic tables as prizes.

The sessions on both days concluded with refreshments, leaving the participants with fond memories of an enriching learning experience. Overall, the visits on 26th and 28th August 2025 provided valuable insights into nuclear energy, radiation safety, and the pioneering role of Indian scientists in this field.







EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO CHENNAI PORT TRUST

On 11th September 2025, the students of Class XI from Sairam Vidyalaya Senior Secondary School, Madipakkam, were taken on an educational field trip to the Chennai Port Trust, **guided by Ms. S. Manimegalai**, **and Ms. K. Srividhya.** The visit was organized to give students an opportunity to witness the working of one of India's most important ports and to connect their classroom learning with real-world applications.

The students, accompanied by teachers, traveled by two school buses and reached the port in the morning. On arrival, they were warmly received by the officials of Chennai Port Trust. The officials welcomed the students with safety caps and refreshments, ensuring that the visit was both safe and comfortable.

After a brief introduction about the port's history and importance, the students were given a guided tour of the premises. They witnessed the loading and unloading of automobiles and containers with the help of advanced cranes and cargo-handling systems. A highlight of the day was observing the arrival of a ship carrying cars for export, which gave the students a first-hand experience of how India's automobile industry connects with global markets.

The port officials also explained the role of different trading divisions that function within the port:

- 4 Automobile Export Division managing export of vehicles to various countries.
- Container Terminal Division handling containerized goods with modern logistics.
- **\$\displays** Bulk Cargo Division dealing with commodities such as coal, iron ore, and fertilizers.
- General Cargo Division taking care of break-bulk and miscellaneous cargo.

Students gained valuable insights into the international trade system, shipping logistics, documentation procedures, and the vital role ports play in boosting India's economy. The session also highlighted various career opportunities in shipping, commerce, engineering, and logistics.

The trip was not only educational but also enjoyable. The hospitality of the port officials, coupled with their detailed explanations, made the experience truly enriching. By the end of the day, students returned with greater awareness, practical knowledge, and fond memories of their visit.








MOTIVATIONAL PROGRAMME FOR STUDENTS AND TEACHERS
